### AQUACULTURE TOUR

**TUESDAY JULY 1 8:00AM-12:00PM**

**Location: Tours depart RICC**

The tour will encompass two main topic areas: aquaculture and bycatch reduction in trawl fisheries. The presentation will be led by two scientists.

Part I: will cover shellfish and finfish aquaculture from biological, engineering, and economic aspects. Participants will visit a working experimental aquaculture facility that has flow through systems, recirculating systems, a shellfish hatchery, and a variety of species of finfish, mollusks, and crustaceans.

Part II: a presentation on the Eliminator Trawl which won the 2007 World Wildlife Fund Smart Gear competition for bycatch reduction in commercial fisheries. The presentation will include the design and function of bottom trawl gear, the fish behavior that makes fisheries conservation engineering possible, the economics, and political aspects of bycatch reduction. A scale model of the Eliminator Trawl will be used to enhance the participants understanding of the concepts involved.

### CENTER FOR SUSTAINABLE LIVING

At the Center, individuals who are experts in sustainable design and technologies designed the showcase house. The house features more than fifty environmentally friendly systems, technologies, and products, including passive and active solar energy systems, natural, recycled and non-toxic building materials and construction, straw-bale walls, radiant flooring and permaculture landscaping. The Center's exhibits explain all the housing model's features, including how they differ from traditional systems, their cost-effectiveness, and their payback periods. After you tour the Center, there will be time to explore the nature trails on your own.

### WIND ENERGY THEN AND NOW: AN EXPLORATION OF THE RE-EMERGENCE OF A CLEAN RESOURCE

**WEDNESDAY JULY 2 2:00PM-6:00PM**

**Location: Tours depart RICC**

Participants in a tour on wind energy offered by two local organizations will learn the key role wind power played in the history of Aquidneck Island and the vital part it can play in its future. The two energy sources are the Newport Restoration Foundation's circa 1811 windmill and the Portsmouth Abbey's brand new wind turbine. In addition to comparing the different technology of the two sources, the program will explore the increasingly popular idea of a return to wind energy. The tour begins at the historic Sherman Mill located at Prescott Farm, in Middletown. Participants will then drive to Portsmouth Abbey to visit the wind turbine.



Originally built in Warren, R.I. for the distillery trade, the Sherman Windmill is a smock mill with two sets of grinding stones, a unique construction that made it possible to run the mill constantly. Moved several times during its active years - a common practice because this valuable machinery was easier to move than to build new - the windmill was eventually abandoned as technology changed. Purchased by the Newport Restoration Foundation, it was moved to Prescott Farm and restored between 1970 and 1972. The mill is open to the public through tours of Prescott Farm, a 37-acre site of 18th and 19th century history.

Operational in April of 2006, the Portsmouth Abbey wind turbine is the first of its kind to be build on a school campus in New England and one of a handful nationwide. Portsmouth Abbey School which previously purchased approximately two million kWh per year estimates that the turbine will supply nearly half of its energy this year. Any excess energy generated will be shared with the community through the electric grid. During the first three months of operation, the Portsmouth Abbey School wind turbine generated 300,000 kWh of power. The small commercial wind turbine stands 240 feet with giant blades accounting for 77 feet of the height.
