ASABE TO REVISE STANDARD ON OPEN CHANNEL DRAINAGE OUTLETS

(ASABE) has initiated the revision of EP407.2, Agricultural Drainage Outlets – Open Channels, to update the definition of drainage coefficient as well as to review and update two-stage channel design.
