T#3 Holland Marsh Agricultural Drainage Tour

Date: Tuesday, July 15, 2025

Time: 12:00 – 6:00 PM

The Holland Marsh is located 50 km north of Toronto in a region that encompasses approximately 2,833 ha and produces a variety of fresh vegetables grown on intensively cultivated muck soils with artificial subsurface drainage. The water management system comprised of canals, dikes, field drainage, and a pumping station is governed by the Holland Marsh Drainage System Joint Municipal Service Board. Agricultural runoff from the Marsh drains to Lake Simcoe and measures are being undertaken to reduce pollutants in the drainage water. The tour includes visits to commercial field operations to learn about the drainage and water management system of the Holland Marsh. This half-day bus tour includes some light walking. Now also includes a box lunch-sponsored by LICO!

Cost: \$60 per person

Includes: Transportation from The Sheraton Centre Hotel to Holland Marsh and throughout the region.

T#4 A Guided Walking Tour of Old Town & St. Lawrence Market
