T#1 Downtown Indianapolis Urban Stormwater BMP Walking Tour

Sunday, 7/12/2026 9:00am - 11:00am Tour

Come experience unique urban stormwater BMPs in downtown Indianapolis, including the Indianapolis Cultural Trail, Market Street Reconstruction, Cummins Distribution Headquarters Plaza and IndyGo Transit Center. Led by Marion County SWCD director John Hazlett and Deb Sahoo, Clemson University, tour participants will visit projects that integrate green infrastructure like rain gardens and water catchment systems that beautify streetscapes and green spaces while reducing the burden on urban stormwater systems. Tour participants will also learn about Pogues Run, a buried stream that runs under Indianapolis, and how the city of Indianapolis supports green infrastructure in urban development projects. Typical maintenance tasks and associated engineering principles with each BMP will also be discussed, along with plant selection and design considerations.

Required items: Walking shoes, a hat is preferred and drinking water, sunscreen if needed.

PDHs: The walking tour will offer two hours of PDHs.

Join us on for a behind-the-scenes look at Indianapolis Motor Speedway.

When the Indianapolis Motor Speedway opened had only 12 cars on display. Today the Museum has become one of the world's premier collections of racing automobiles and artifacts – with more than 55,000 artifacts and over 150 vehicles. In fact, the Indianapolis Motor Speedway Museum has been named one of USA Today's "Top Three Best Sports Attractions in the Country" as well as "Museum of the Year" by the International Historic Motoring Awards. The 80,000 sq. ft. space contains vintage cars, trophies, photographs, fine art, and other artifacts that capture the cultural significance of motorsports.

Optional: Whether you're a die-hard racing fan or just want to experience an iconic piece of sports history please join us after the museum tour for the "Kiss the Bricks" tour – a narrated, 30-minute bus tour that features one lap around the famous 2.5-mile oval with a stop at the start/finish line and the historic yard of bricks. Since 1996, race-winning drivers have celebrated their victory by kissing the bricks. Now, you can experience this tradition for yourself! Additional \$15 to cost of main museum tour.
